**PUBLIC NOTICE  
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS  
REGARDING TRANSEINT MOORINGS IN THREE MILE HARBOR**

WHEREAS, the Trustees of the Freeholders and Commonalty of the Town of East Hampton are the owners in fee tile of the bottomland of Three Mile Harbor, and'

WHEREAS, in addition to the Trustees inherent powers as owners of said bottomland, §246-3 of the East Hampton Town Code, specifically states the authority of the Trustees in Trustee waters and on Trustee beaches, to regulate the placement of boats and floats; and the location of moorings and anchoring areas. The Trustees of the Freeholders and commonalty of the Town of east Hampton and/or their designated agent shall supervise, and control said activities. All boats shall be placed, anchored or moored in or on such Trustee waters and beaches in compliance with such regulations as the Trustees shall duly adopts, and;

WHEREAS, the convenience of transient moorings has been made available to boaters in Three Mile Harbor in the past, the Trustees feel that the community can best be served by hiring a manager to handle their Transient Mooring program over the next five (5) years.

NOW, THEREORE BE IT RESOLVED, that, a Request for Proposals, shall be public noticed, by publication on \_\_\_\_\_ in the East Hampton Star, the Trustees official newspaper of record, that the Trustees are posting a Request for Proposals for the management of up to Ten (10) Transient mooring spots, the location of which are pre-established by the Trustees, for the Season of 2025 through the Season of \_\_\_\_\_, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proposal expects the moorings and gear to be purchased by the applicant, the mooring will be installed, maintained and removed annually by the applicant, the applicant will collect a reasonable nightly fee, no single vessel will be connected to the mooring for more than seven (7) consecutive nights, and;
