**ADOPTING MUTLI-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT APPLICATION FEES**

**WHEREAS**, the Trustees of the Freeholders and Commonalty of the Town of East Hampton, (“Trustees”), require General Permits (“Permits”) for certain work and activities undertaken on Trustee property for the benefit of the upland property owner, and;

**WHEREAS**, traditionally Permits have been approved for a term of one year and over the past several years the Trustees have received an increase in the number of requests from applicants and/or their agents to obtain permits which are valid for multiple years, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Trustees have granted these requests and approved several multi-year permits for work or activity on Trustee owned property in an effort to align Trustee permit terms with other regulatory agency permit terms, and;

**WHEREAS**, according to Trustee Resolution #2026-22 (Annual Fee Schedule), an initial application fee of \$125.00 is to be paid by the applicant upon submission of the application, and a renewal fee of \$100.00 per year for each additional year of the permit will be paid in full upon approval, and;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that in 2026 and every year thereafter, application requests for multi-year permits will incur an initial fee, based on the Annual Fee Schedule for that year, to be paid by the applicant upon submission of the application, and a renewal fee for each additional year of the permit, similarly based on the Annual Fee Schedule for that year, that will be paid in full upon approval of the General Permit Application and will be viewed as a singular permit.
